ARVIND KEJRIWAL: DELHI CABINET APPROVES SETTING UP OF SPORTS UNIVERSITY

“The Delhi government will open Sports University in the National Capital,” said Arvind Kejriwal (Chief Minister of Delhi) on Thursday. It has been time that sports education be given formally as part of the mainstream subjects.

In a Press Conference on Thursday, Kejriwal said that a Bill was approved by the Cabinet on Thursday and it will be sent to Lt. Governor Anil Baijal. Afterwards, the bill will be tabled in the Delhi Assembly, he informed.

Arvind Kejriwal added further that the ‘Sports University’ will be opened on 90 acre of land in Munda area. This move is aimed to promote sports in the city, he said.
